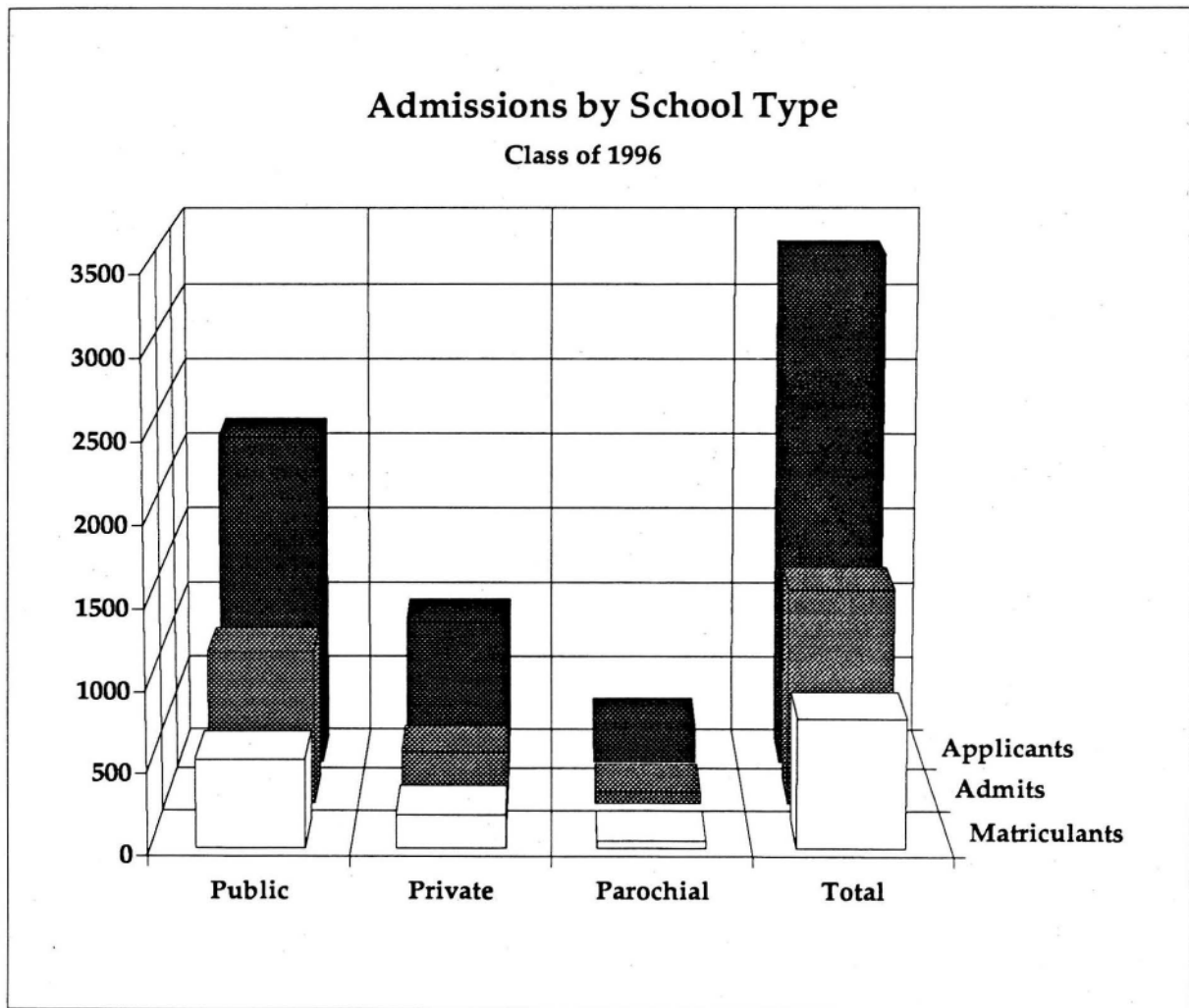

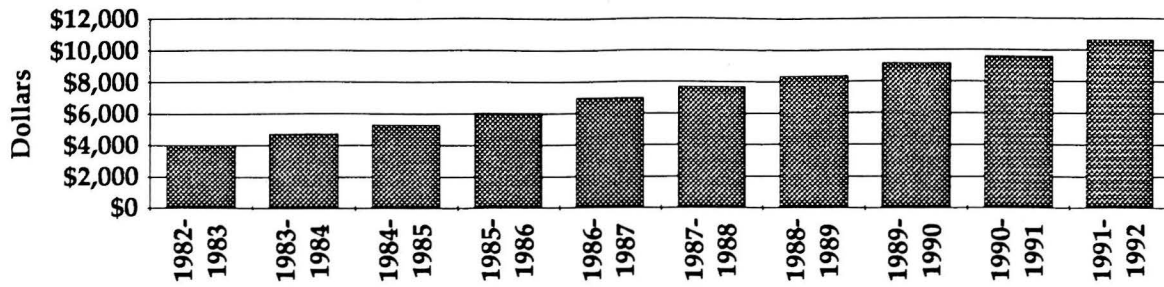

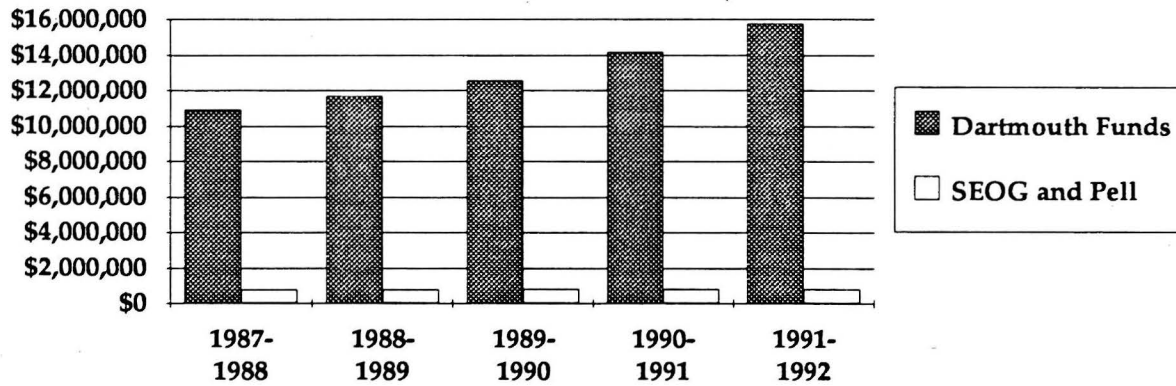
### Average Scholarship per Recipient



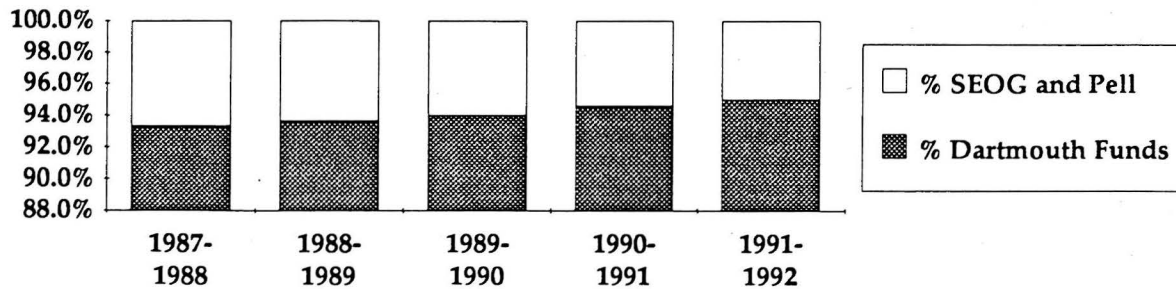

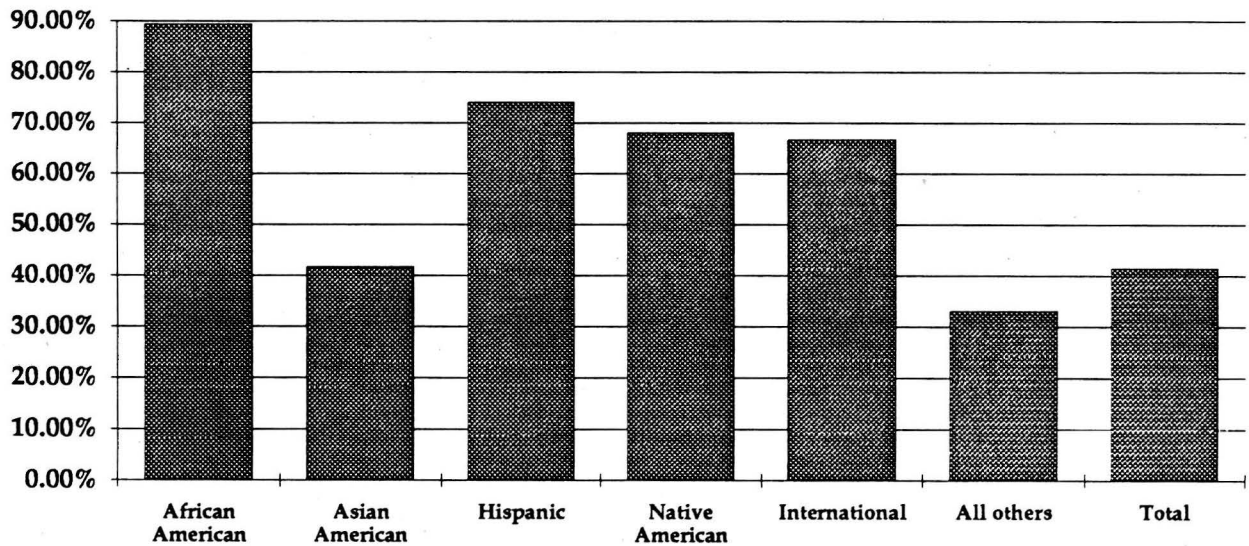

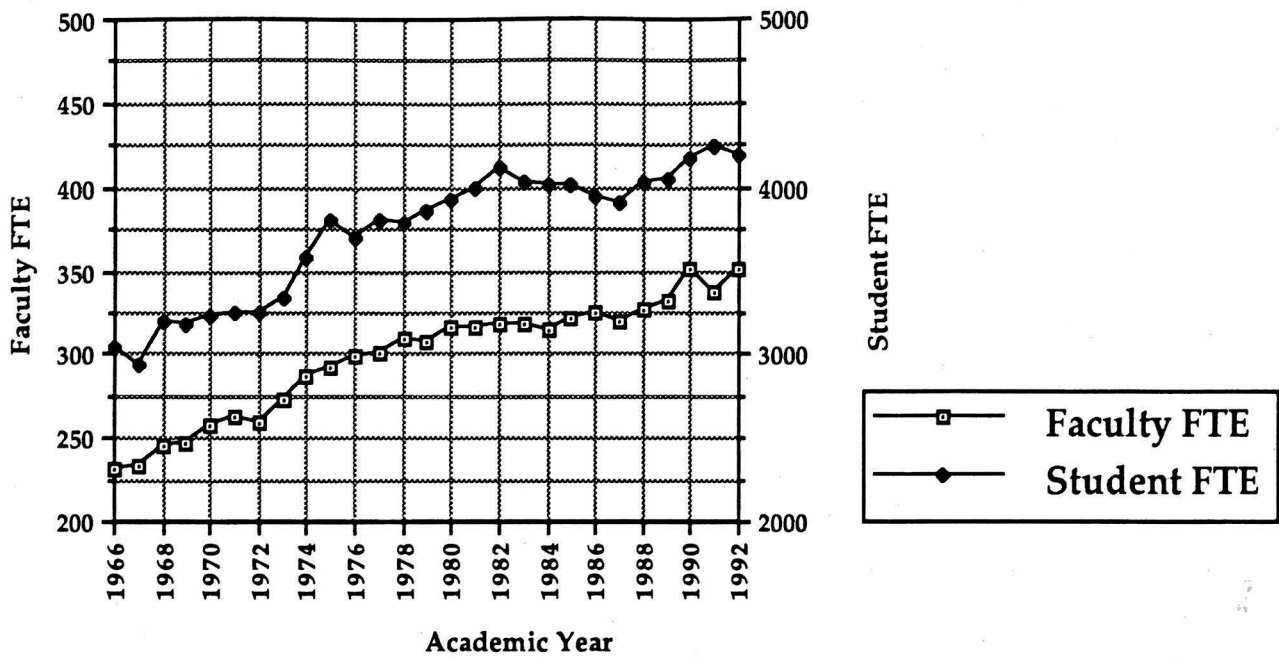

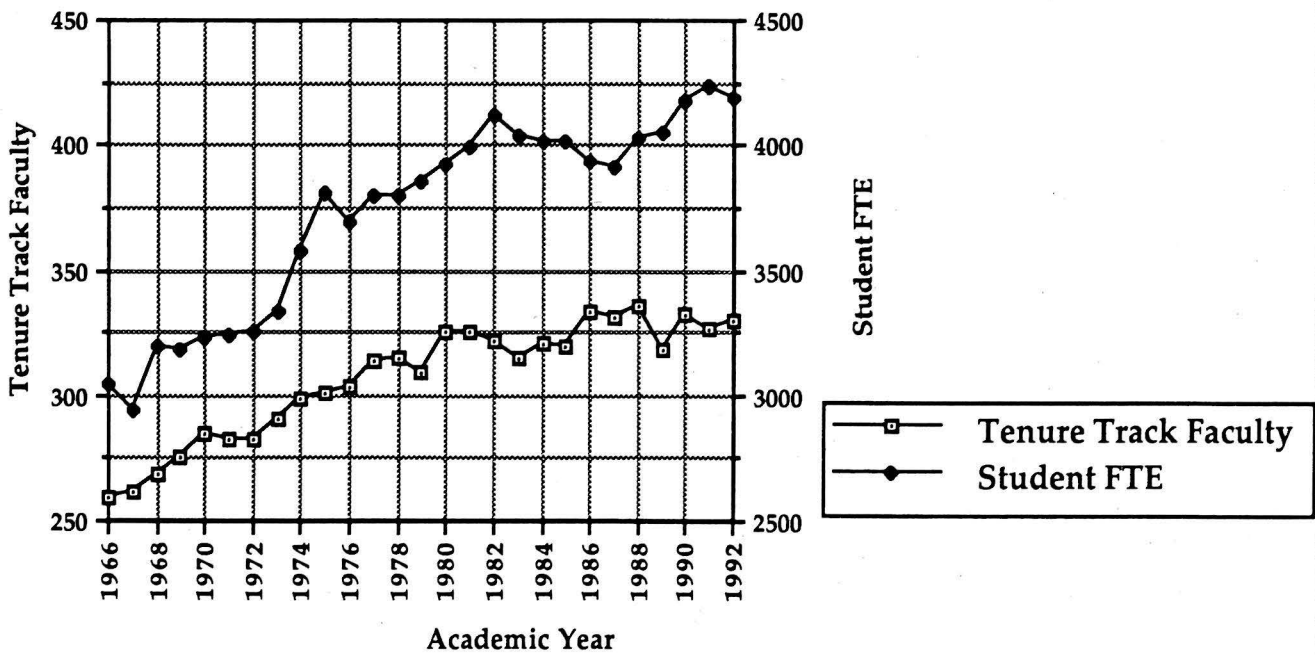

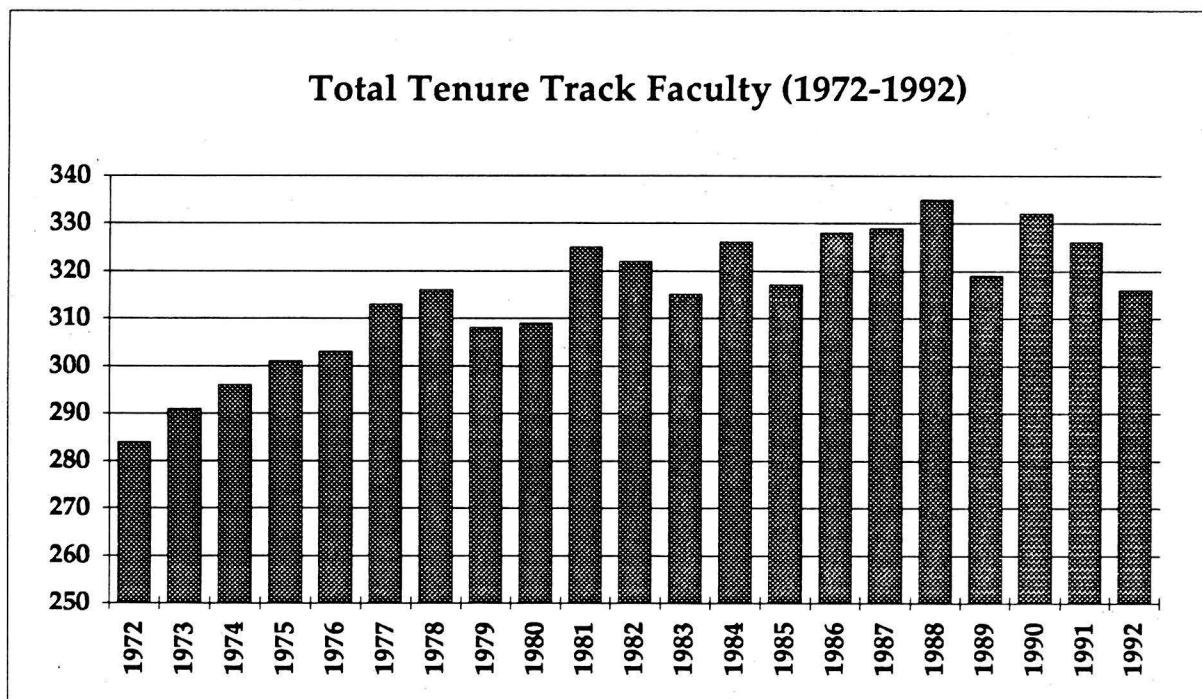

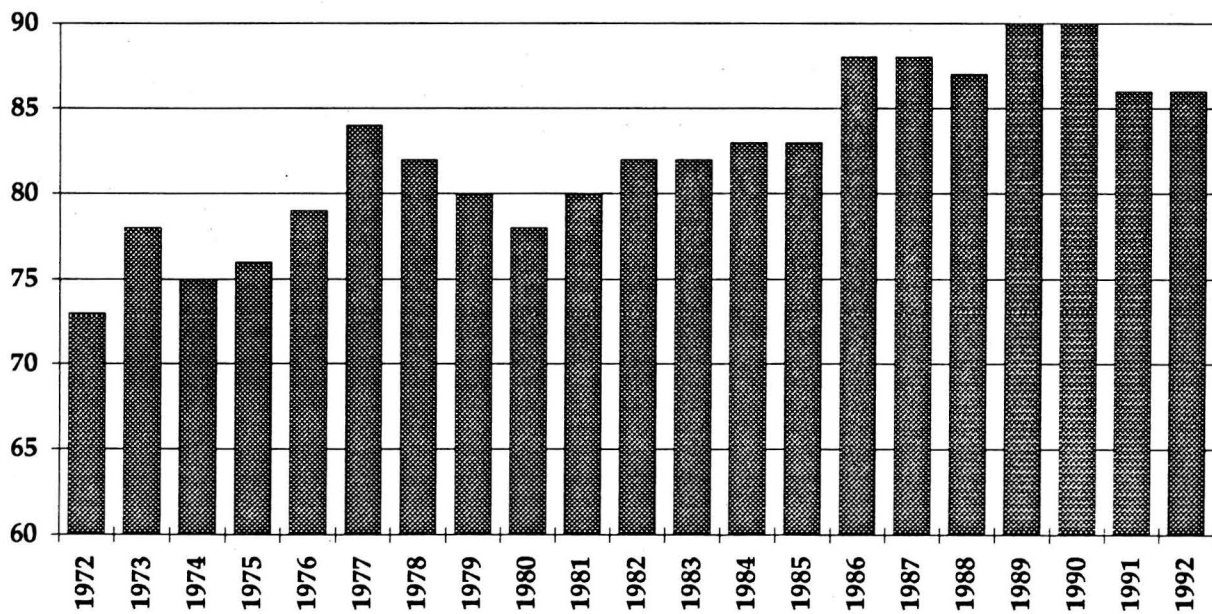

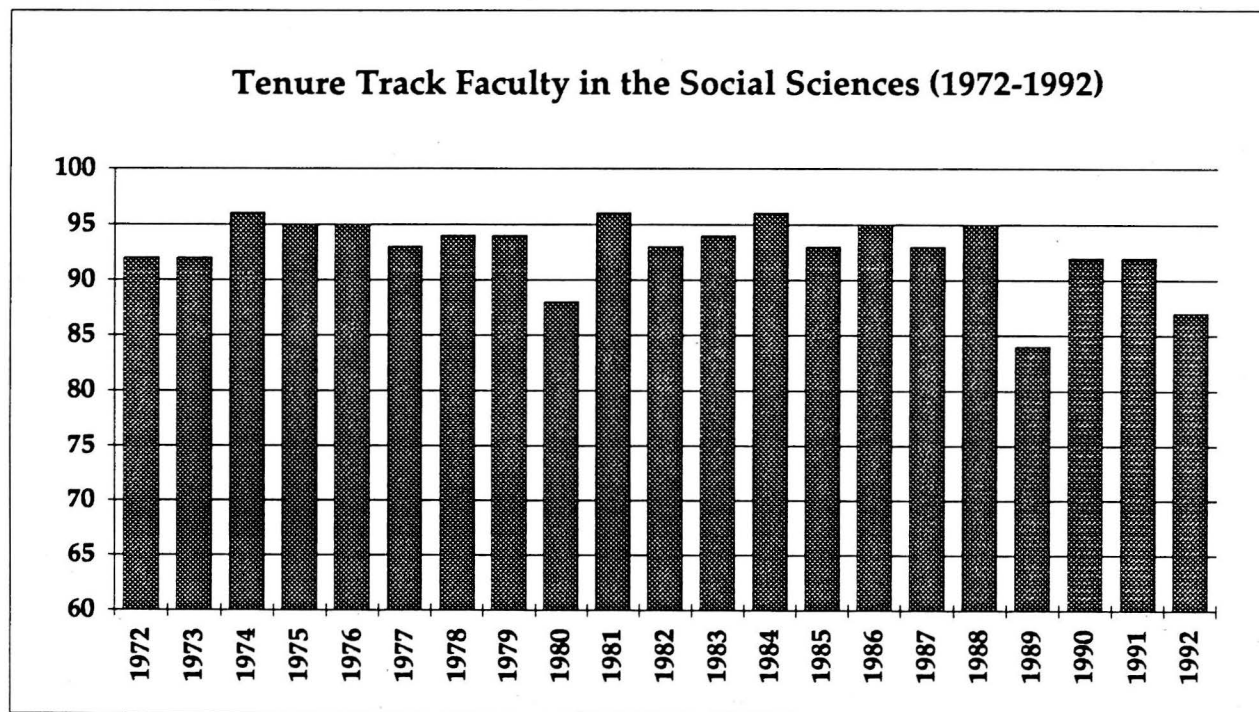

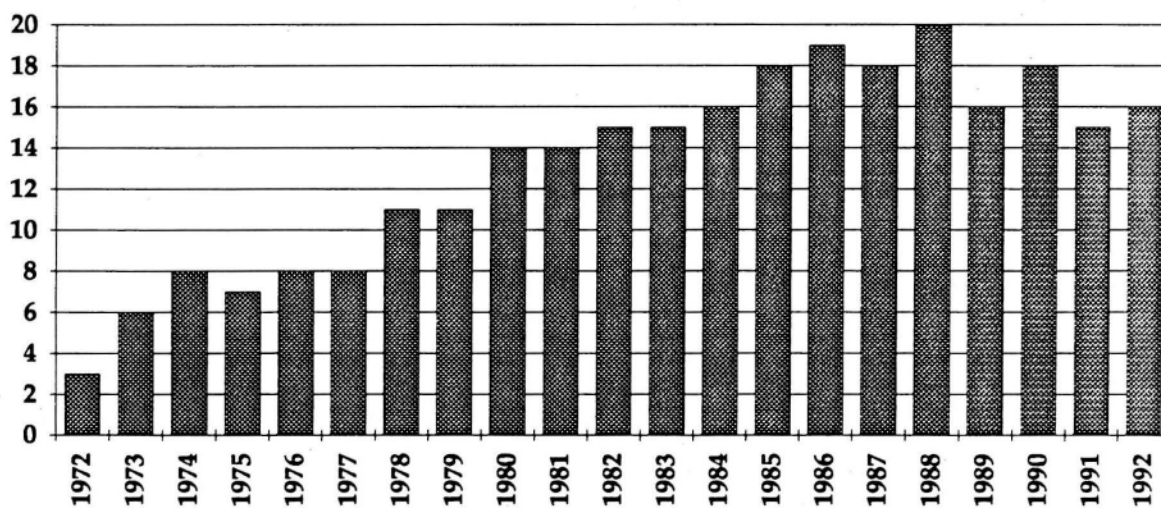

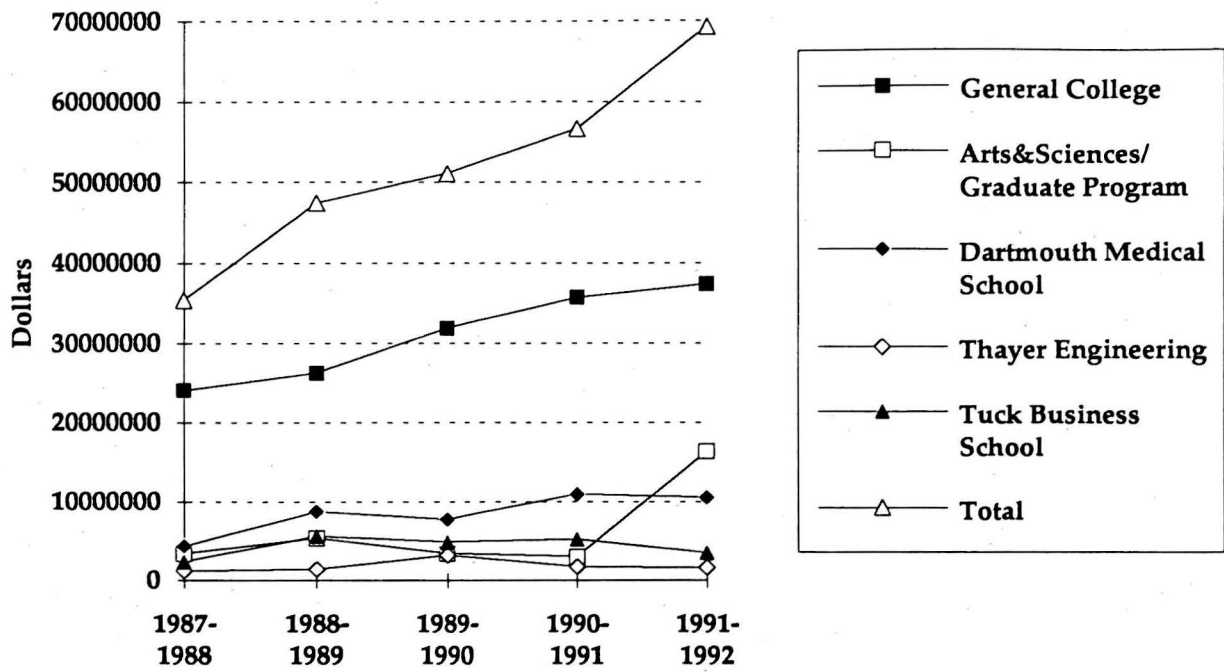

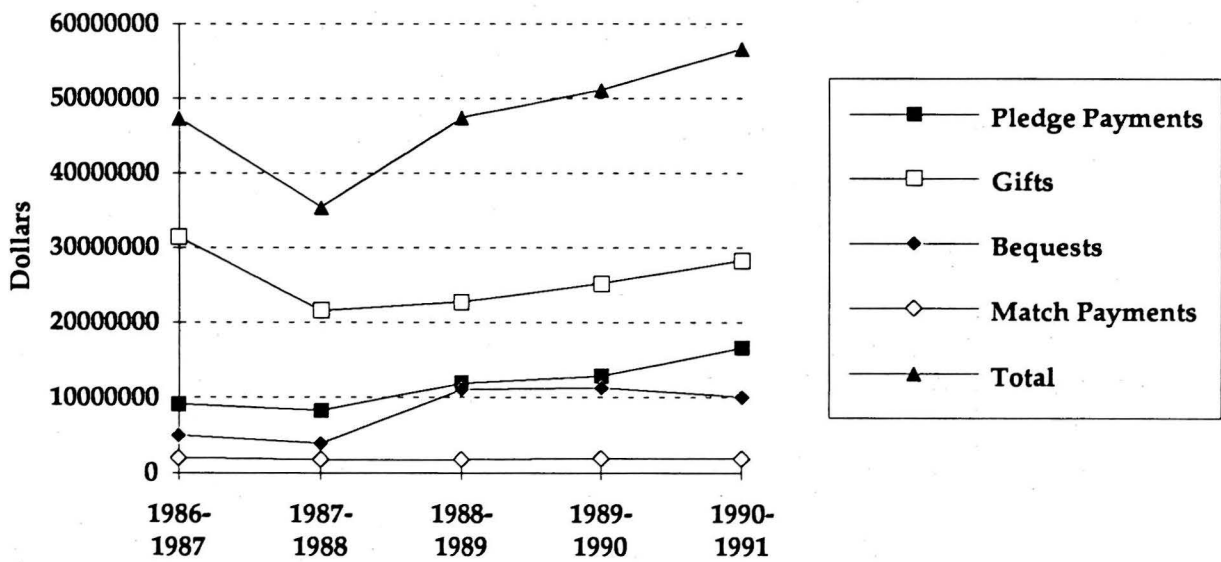

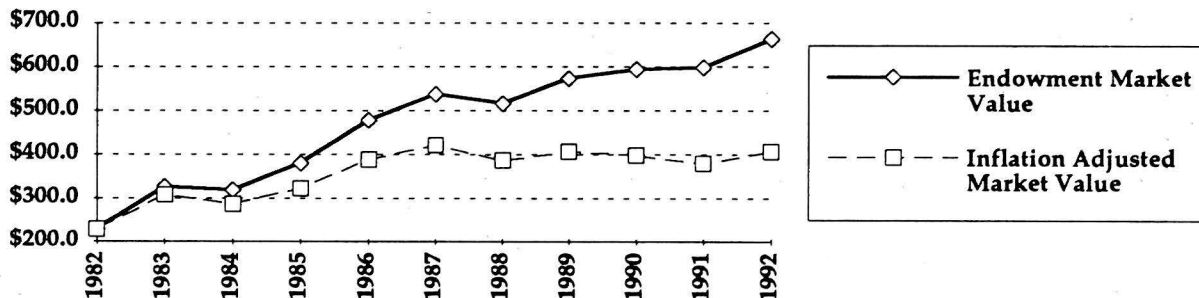

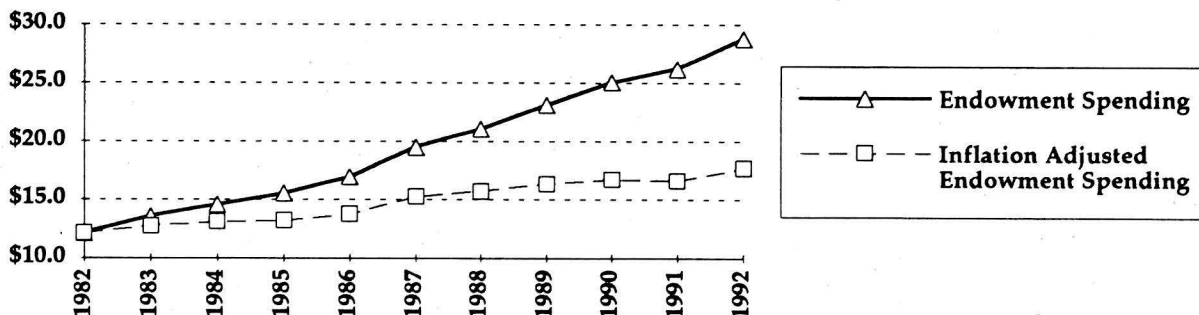

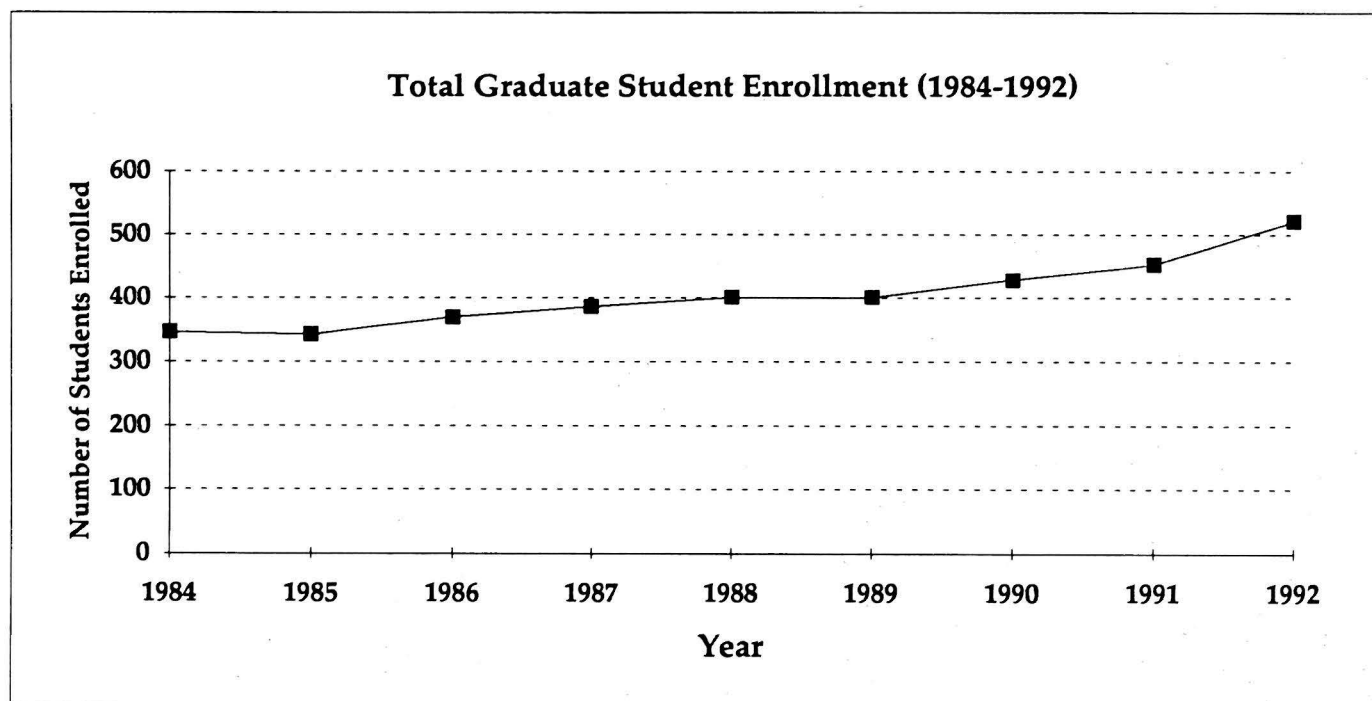
